

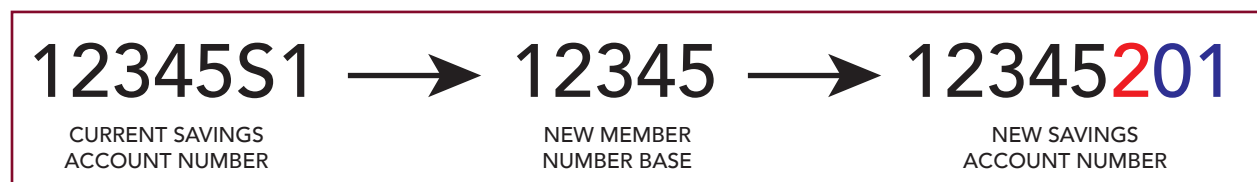


CORE BANKING SYSTEM UPGRADE

This upgrade will allow us to better secure your account information, provide greater member service as well as enhance your member experience.

Over the next few months, our teams will be working diligently to create a seamless experience and minimize impact to your services due to this upgrade. You will receive numerous communications regarding the upgrade and what to expect.

One important change you need to know about involves the structure of your member account number. Your new account number will use part of your old account number with the addition of new account codes and suffixes:



In the above example, the 2 represents the account type and the 01 represents the number of that type of account. So, 201 would be savings account number 1.

If you have multiple savings accounts, they will be designated as 201, 202, 203 and so on. If you have different member account numbers, the oldest account number will be used for your new base member number for all accounts:
