





UPDATE FOR SHARED BRANCHING USERS

Greater TexaslAggieland Credit Union is undergoing a Core Banking System Upgrade. This upgrade will allow for enhanced security, more robust technology integrations, and even greater member service.

One important adjustment you need to know about involves the structure of your member number and account numbers. After the Upgrade, the credit union's new Core Banking System will feature a single, centralized membership number per person that arches over individual, numeric account numbers. Most checking and money market account numbers will remain the same. Other accounts, such as savings accounts, certificates, and loans, will have a new, unique account number. The credit union will no longer use an alphanumeric system (S, I, or L suffix codes) to designate account types. This change will not affect your Visa debit or credit card(s), you may continue to use those as normal.

IMPORTANT: After the Upgrade you will need to use your new member number when transacting with a Shared Branch Credit Union. Your previous member number may no longer generate your Greater TexaslAggieland account for our partnering credit unions. More information about your new member number will be provided to you through the mail before the Upgrade, so please keep an eye on your mailbox.
